Dr Eugene Garfield's legacy to science and metrics



Webinar sponsored by Clarivate Analytics

Hundreds of participants from around the world joined us for this webinar – presented by Henry Small and Richard Gallagher. You can see a recording of it will [be available here](#) shortly.

As a pioneer in automated indexing and retrieval of information, Eugene Garfield developed numerous citation databases that have changed how scientists search and assess scholarly literature. These include the Clarivate Analytics Web of Science, which indexes the contents and the citation network of the world's premier scientific and scholarly journals and proceedings, and his Journal Citation Reports, which provides journal impact factors and other citation metrics describing the influence of journals and how they are related to one another. These are but two of Garfield's unprecedented, valuable, and enduring inventions. Given his influence on scientists and scholars around the world, and his generosity as an employer and mentor, Garfield touched innumerable lives, and not just of those who knew him. The functionality of Google's search engine descends directly from his ideas and papers. Also, many treatments, cures, advances and inventions were undoubtedly accelerated by researchers who used Garfield's citation-indexing tools to turn their work in the right direction at the right time, realizing connections they otherwise might have missed.

Eugene Garfield had many interests related to information science and technology, but one of the key threads across all of them is the use of citations (cited references) in information retrieval, research assessment, and the study of the science of science, a subject upon which this webcast will focus, especially regarding how we use these tools today.

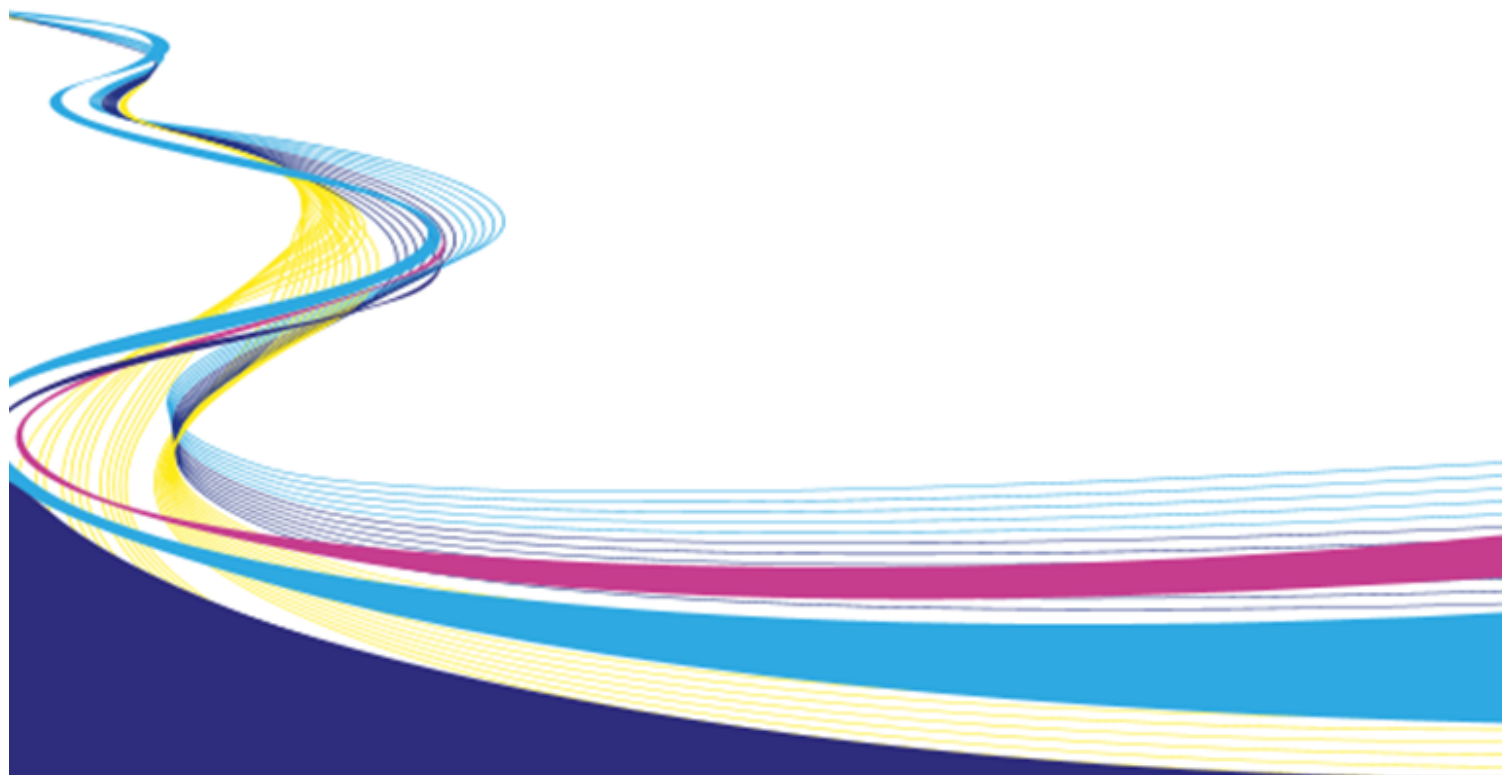
